habitat for animals and shelters a
portion of the Niagara Escarpment.
We’ll see exposed dolostone rock,
many bedrock fractures and eroded
talus slopes of the Escarpment. 4174

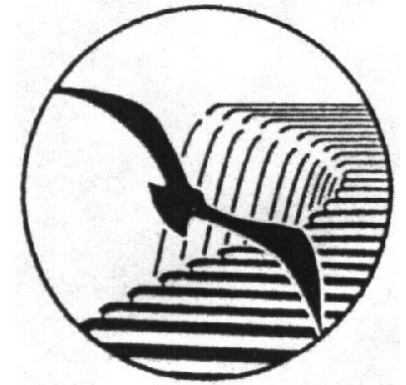
